RE: AUDITING SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025, 2026, AND 2027

As of June 30 of each year, the Board of Education shall initiate an audit of its financial statements by a person lawfully qualified to practice public accounting as regulated by the Illinois Public Accounting Act. The audit will be conducted in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, Governments Auditing Standards issued by the Comptroller General of the United States, the provisions of the Single Audit Act, and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-133.

The audit shall include a review of the system of internal controls to ensure that that there is effective control over revenues, expenditures, assets and liabilities, and proper accounting of resources, and accounting operations. The audit shall also consist of tests of compliance with requirements of applicable state laws and regulations of material effect on the District's financial statements.

The Board of Education has utilized the auditing services of Baker Tilly US, LLP, for the past five years. Historically, District 200, in an effort to provide comparative pricing and review of services, has conducted a request for proposal for auditing services every five years. Therefore, a request for proposal for auditing services for fiscal years 2025, 2026, and 2027 was conducted. Four firms that were directly requested from, and one firm that saw the RFP on the district website, responded with proposals: Baker Tilly US, LLP; Lauterbach & Amen, LLP; Crowe; CliftonLaursonAllen (CLA) LLP; and Sikich LLP. All firms have experience in auditing school districts in Illinois.

Considering each firm's level of expertise, capacity, and cost proposals, it is recommended that the Board of Education engage the auditing services of Lauterbach & Amen, LLP. Through consultations with districts that currently utilize Lauterbach & Amen's auditing services it was noted that they have proven to be reliable, efficient, and independent, providing not only a quality audit and report, but valuable financial consultation on technical issues. The proposed fees for auditing services for fiscal years 2025, 2026, and 2027 are \$48,450, \$50,850, and \$53,400 respectively. The proposed fees include the Base Audit Report with the Management Letter, Activity Accounts, and the Single Audit. By comparison, the cost for the auditing services of Baker Tilly US, LLP was \$62,315 for fiscal year 2024.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board of Education hire Lauterbach & Amen, LLP, to provide auditing services for fiscal year 2025 in an amount not to exceed \$48,450; for fiscal year 2026 an amount not to exceed \$50,850; and for fiscal year 2027 an amount not to exceed \$53,400.
