

Policy 7:30 Student Assignment and Intra-District Transfer

Attendance Areas

The School District is divided into school attendance areas. The Superintendent will:

1. Review the boundary lines annually and recommend to the School Board any changes or revisions for existing units; or
2. Create any recommendations for new units using a lens that considers preventing segregation and the elimination of separating students in the District's schools because of color, race, or nationality.

The Superintendent or designee shall maintain a map of the District showing current school attendance areas. All records pertaining to the creation, alteration, or revision of attendance units are open to the public. Students living in a given school attendance area will be assigned to that school. Homeless children shall be assigned according to policy 6:140, *Education of Homeless Children*.

Transfers Within the District

A student's parent(s)/guardian(s) may request a transfer for their child to a District school other than the one assigned. A request should be directed to the Superintendent, who, at his or her sole discretion, may grant the request when the parent(s)/guardian(s) demonstrate that the student could be better accommodated at another school, provided space is available. If a request is granted, the parent/guardian shall be responsible for transportation. The provisions in this section have no applicability to transfers pursuant to the Unsafe School Choice Option covered in Board policy 4:170, *Safety*.

Class Assignments

The Superintendent or designee shall assign students to classes.

Which neighborhoods are involved?

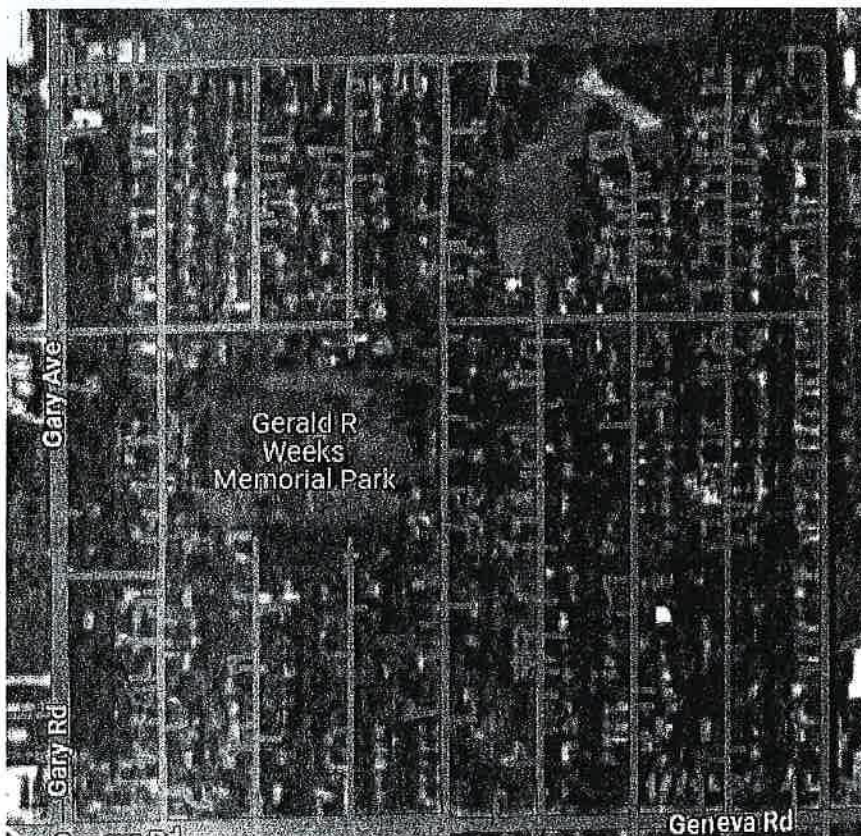
Gary Gardens

Gary Gardens is a subdivision of single-family homes in unincorporated Carol Stream. It is bounded by Geneva Road, Gary Avenue, West Street, and Tubeway Drive.

While a distant satellite view may show what appears to be a significant number of vacant lots, a closer inspection revealed that the majority were either additional lots appended to a larger home or designated wildlife areas.

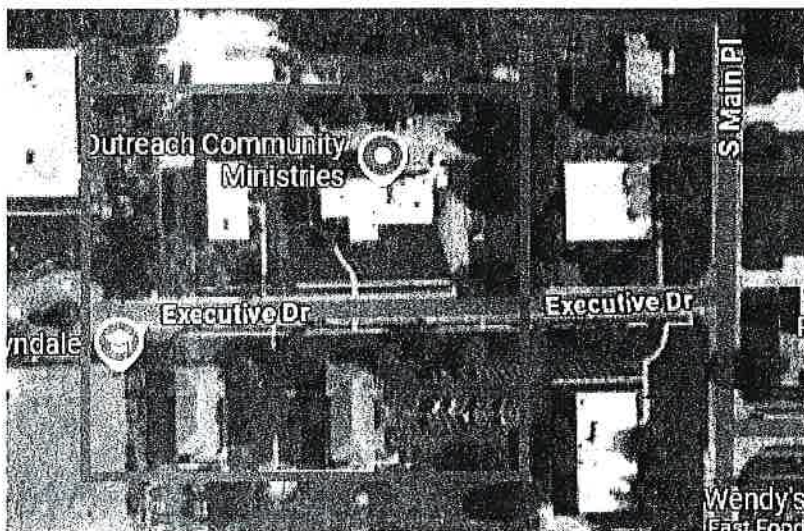
Within the subdivision, there are four empty lots that do not appear to be combined with others, along with one home currently under construction.

Along the east side of Gary Avenue, there are 12 vacant lots, but many of the buildings adjoining them are used commercially.



Executive Drive Apartments

There are four mid-to-large size apartment buildings on Executive Drive one block north of Schmale Road.



Carol Stream Crossing 2

Carol Stream Crossing 2 is one of three formerly separate apartment complexes now consolidated under a single owner.

It consists of four large apartment buildings located at 550 - 590 Gundersen Drive, near the intersection of Gundersen and Schmale Road in South Carol Stream.
